Saturday, 14th September 2pm, Leamington Station, led by Friends of Leamington Station

Guided walk round the gardens, giving their history an explanation of the recent project to restore the bandstand and improve the gardens. Meet at the Bandstand

Thursday, 19th September 2.30pm, Guided walk around Jephson Gardens, led by Sidney Syson (Chair of the Society)

The Jephson Gardens are a very special place in Leamington. Come and take a tour of the gardens learning their history and identifying some of its interesting trees. Meet at the entrance to Jephson Gardens, opposite the Pump Rooms
